Bringing Finance Information and Assistance Services to Women in Kabul

Conducting On-site Finance Information Services:

The second component of the project is the operation of an on-site finance information and referral service exclusively for women. According to the project the on-site finance information services should be operating in at least 3 locations in Kabul city. At each site, the finance booth will open for 7 continuous days (including weekends and holidays) at 10 hours daily. The first on-site finance information booth has conducted in female park (Bagh-e-Zanana). The first booth was conducted during Saturday Feb.24- Friday March.02.2018, for the seven continues days, 10 hours daily. In this finance information services booth, NECDO employees` provided information about access to financial institutions, financial services, bank accounts, loan accounts, starting business, and financial rights of women from Islamic prospect.

Totally more than 100 women from various professional backgrounds received these on-site financial information services in this booth. The two remaining on-site financial information services booth will be conducted in the month of March. Women who received the information learned more about financial institutions and their services. Women were motivated to start new business, to become self-sufficient. In addition, they suggested preparing micro finance services to them.

During this on-site financial information booth, our employees presented information about bank accounts, loan accounts, credit cards, debits cards and all those products which banking financial institutions and non-banking financial institutions are presenting to customer.

This report is covering the end of March, we conducted two booths in the month of April, which will be shared the information in the final report. The financial information campaign will be continued till 15th April. 2018on.





Who we are?

Noor Educational and Capacity Development **Organization** (NECDO) is a non-governmental, impartial and non-political organization, registered with Ministry of Economy in 2002 with INO.95. NECDO was established in January 2001 by a group of volunteers to help and support needy Afghan women, youth, and children when the Afghan nation was passing through time-tested moments of its history in Peshawar Afghan Refugee Camps. The destructive civil war resulted in material and spiritual losses for the nation. NECDO started its activities with little means, but greatness of purpose, which was based on humanitarian development assistance. 
