WOMEN CAPACITY BUILDING PROJECT

The capacity-building training for 103 women, (students and teachers) was successfully held in NECDO-Nazo Ana Library Hall, this was the most comprehensive training for the students who are deprived from schools and were impacted by the current critical political situation of Afghanistan, the training consists of the most important issue and topics. The program's goal is to help students learn and build their skills. Students from various schools throughout the province of Kabul participated in this program and learned about the topics. The topics covered in this program were both interesting and novel to the students, and

NECDO made an effort to educate them about issues primarily related to technology, leadership, networking, management, and women's rights with regard to Islamic values. NECDO aimed to transfer essential concerns to students so that they might then transfer them to others.

Training Time:

The trainings were designed in two rounds of three full days each and the participants were divided in groups of 20 . Each round of the training was held in brake of 15 to 20 days.

Most of the people who live in Kabul city are running their life with daily wages due to poverty. The political, social, and economic changes have restricted in particularly women to go out for job or earn money. It is impossible to earn the money for family in this situation compared to pay for rent and other expenses. Women and widow are mostly affected people because the policies of the current new government increased the domestic violence and economic conditions. The proposed intervention is the well justified action to provide temporary support to the targeted number of households in these unexpected and un-estimated situations.

Based on this NECDO distributed the cash during the month of December 2022 with presence of WFP field monitor, TPM and management staff of NECDO. Cash was distributed to (15050) of families.

UNCONDITIONAL SEASONAL SUPPORT PROJECT (UCSSP) FOOD AND CASH DISTRIBUTIONS – MAIDAN WARDAK

Unconditional Seasonal Support (KAO-SO1-NECDO-AF01-1305) is a 3-month project covering the vulnerable families affected by COVID-19, poverty, and the recent political and social changes in different districts of Maidan Wardak province. This project covers Maidan SHAHR, District of JALRIZ, and District of NARKH of Maidan Wardak province. It covers 8,200 families in Maidan Shahr, 3,000 families in District of JALRIZ, 2,600 families in District of NARKH, 2,600 families in total it covers 8,200 vulnerable families. The vulnerable families include widows, disables, orphans, the families living in tents, the families which were living in rented houses, and most importantly the affected people of COVID-19 and poverty. The project includes sub-activities for completing the milestones in each district the vulnerable families are identified by focal point/local representative (Wakil-e-Guzar) in each district. The identified families should be surveyed by NECDO relief program team and accordingly the vulnerable families are selected based on their physical and social status for cash assistance of this project.
